

# A RIGHT TO SAME-SEX MARRIAGE DOESN'T MAKE FIRST AMENDMENT RIGHTS DISAPPEAR.

In a few days, the Connecticut legislature will take up Bill 899, which implements the state Supreme Court's same-sex marriage decision.

But Bill 899 provides no significant protection for First Amendment religious freedoms. It does not recognize the fundamental right — found in both the U.S. and Connecticut Constitutions — of churches, religious groups, and individuals to act in accordance with their sincerely held religious beliefs.

Please call or write your state senator and representative and tell them that you oppose any same-sex marriage legislation that does not include first amendment religious liberty protection.
