## Proposition 4

### Likely Voters

There will be a number of propositions on the ballot this November. Proposition 4 is the “Waiting Period and Parental Notification Before Termination of Minor’s Pregnancy” Initiative. It would prohibit abortions for minors under the age of 18 until 48 hours after a physician notifies the minor’s parent, legal guardian, or adult family member. It provides for exceptions for a medical emergency. If the election were being held today, would you vote Yes or No on Proposition 4?
