## CHARITABLE PROGRAM SPOTLIGHT: HABITAT FOR HUMANITY

**I**n this new fraternal year, councils need encouragement to do charitable service. District deputies are uniquely positioned to help council officers focus on worthwhile programs. One popular program to consider is Habitat for Humanity.

Habitat for Humanity is a nonprofit, Christian organization founded in 1976 that seeks to eliminate poverty and homelessness one family at a time. The organization helps provide quality-built, affordable homes to needy families by cooperatively involving the future homeowners with the community volunteers and suppliers to build the home.

To date, Habitat for Humanity has helped build 80,000 houses in 1,400 communities in over 70 countries worldwide, providing safe homes for more than 4 million people.

The Knights of Columbus enthusiastically supports the mission of Habitat for Humanity. Councils, assemblies and circles are encouraged to promote this program to their membership.
