



FEBRUARY 2017 WINTER BLAST JURISDICTIONAL INTAKE CONTEST RULES

In January 2017, the Supreme Knight challenged us all to increase our efforts with respect to membership growth. The challenge is to exceed last year's membership milestones and ensure consistent and sustained membership growth.

In line with this challenge, the February Winter Blast contest will reward jurisdictions that either:

- exceed their February 2016 performance by 3% or more; OR
- exceed their jurisdictional average established in advance of the January Winter Blast contest by 3% or more; whichever number is *greater*.

This number can be found under the "Contest Benchmark" column in the chart on the next page.

Remember, this contest is based upon your jurisdiction's ability to exceed its own past performance. The contest **is not** based on a percentage of your jurisdiction's Circle of Honor quota.
